Multiple Sclerosis (MS) is an inflammatory disease of the central nervous system (CNS). Approximately 400,000 Americans are afflicted with MS and 200 people are diagnosed every week. Worldwide, MS effects more than 2.5 million people.

Symptoms of MS

- Abnormal fatigue
- Episodes of numbness and tingling (parasthesias)
- Loss of balance
- Loss of muscle coordination
- Speech difficulty
- Incontinence of bowel/bladder
- Tremors
- Cognitive changes
- Psychological changes
- Ataxia
- Spasticity

Treatments For MS

Some medications given via intravenous infusion, intramuscularly, or subcutaneously can be provided by a home infusion pharmacy.

- Copaxone (Glatiramer acetate)
- Avonex/Rebif (Interferon beta-1a)
- Tysabari (Natalizumab)
- Betaseron (Interferon beta-1b)
- Solu-Medrol (Methylprednisolone)
