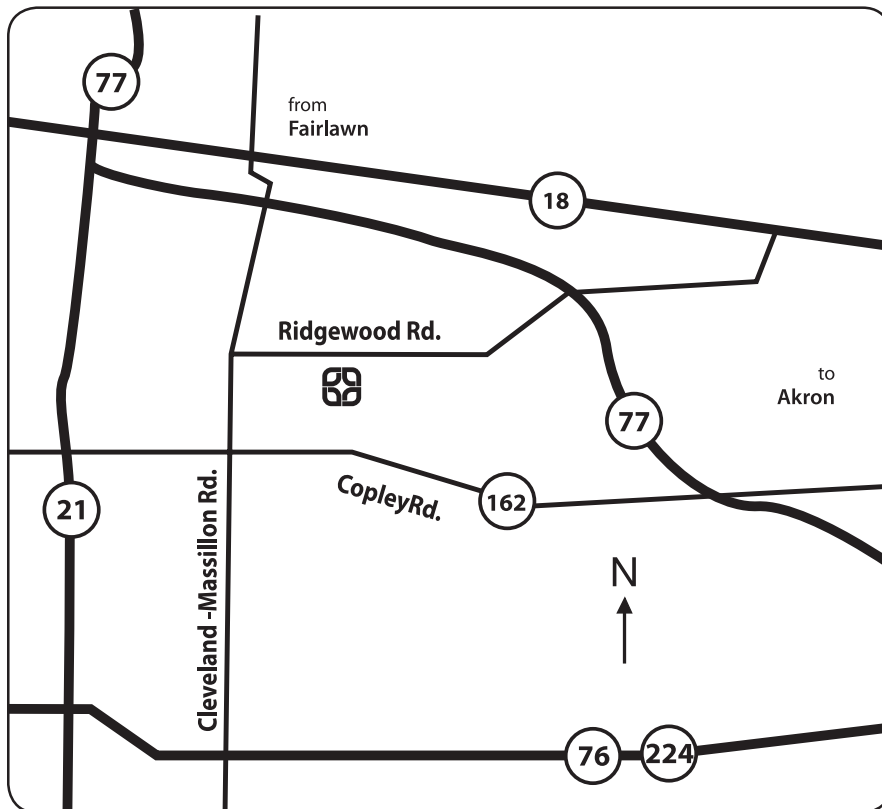


Services & Directions



From 77:

Traveling on Interstate 77, exit at Miller Rd/Ridgewood Rd. Turn west onto Ridgewood Road. The Hospice of Visiting Nurse Justin T. Rogers Care Center will be on your left after approximately 1 mile.

From South on 21:

Traveling North on Route 21, exit at Route 162. Turn right onto Route 162/Copley Road. Turn left at Cleveland-Massillon Road. Continue on Cleveland-Massillon Road, then turn right onto Ridgewood Road. The Hospice of Visiting Nurse Justin T. Rogers Care Center will be on your right.

Hospice provides care and support for persons in the last phases of a life-limiting illness so that they may live as fully and as comfortably as possible. Hospice will help the patient and the family by:

- Managing pain and distressful symptoms
- Teaching families how to comfort and care for their loved ones
- Offering support for problems, questions, medication adjustments or reassurance 24 hours a day
- Covering medications, medical equipment, and supplies related to the illness
- Providing assistance with personal care (baths, meals, light housekeeping)
- Helping to strengthen relationships with loved ones
- Assisting with the burdens of decision-making at the end of life
- Providing bereavement and spiritual care support for the patient and family.
